Meet **Eliza Mabway** who works at one of the 18 distribution points in her village of Banyibanyi. Eliza is grateful for how this work has changed her life.

She says, *"I didn't have a job before this one. In our village, as elsewhere in Tanzania, it is very difficult to find a decent job if you didn't attend college. This work gives me a chance to help my husband, who is a farmer, to take care of our family. I always get 10% of the whole day's collection from this distribution point. This water project has not only solved our water crisis as a village, but it has also saved my family financially as now I have a job that helps feed my four children."*
